At a glance

The 2021 EU Health Award will recognise and reward community-based initiatives alleviating the mental health impact of COVID-19.

Applications submitted under the 2021 EU Health Award must have started and been put into practice in 2020 and/or 2021.

Initiatives could include actions raising awareness, tackling prejudice and/or stigma, bridging or complementing service gaps and/or delays that have arisen from disrupted mental health service provision as a consequence of the pandemic, among others.



Who is eligible?

Local authorities or affiliated organisations as well as NGOs or other not-for-profit organisations established in any EU Member State (find more information in the 2021 EU Health Award website).



The winners

Prizes for each category (three local authorities or affiliated organisations and six NGOs or other not-for-profit organisations) are:

First winner: EUR 30 000 Second winner: EUR 20 000 Third winner: EUR 12 000



In addition, three to six shortlisted initiatives per category will each be awarded a certificate and EUR 1 500.
