


Public health

On 08 April 2022 the Commission amended the second EU4Health work programme and added a specific action in support of promoting best practices to improve **mental health** for displaced vulnerable groups from Ukraine relocated in the EU.

The budget available is $\notin 2$ million. The Health and Digital Executive Agency (HaDEA) will manage the programme. The call was published on 20 April on the <u>F&T Portal</u>.

The programme will provide funding to eligible entities NGOs and stakeholders involved at building capacity to improve mental health and psychological wellbeing with a special focus on Ukraine's displaced people.

The information session is organised by HaDEA with the participation of DG Santé to present the policy context, objectives and expected impact as well as the procedure for this action grant.
