#### **HERA 'Preparatory Actions'**

- In parallel to the establishment process of HERA, preparatory actions are being launched.
- Funding from EU4Health (60M in total for 2021)
- The objectives:
  - to test a number of solutions that could serve as a blueprint for future HERA functions
  - provide indications on the added value of its interventions and possible areas for improvement.



#### HERA 'preparatory actions' in EU4Health 2021 WP

- AMR Preparation of HERA (EUR 2M): a service contract for needs assessment and technology review reports (to feed into future work to bring AMR medical countermeasures to market); a service contract for a feasibility study on AMR stockpiling.
- INTELLIGENCE GATHERING AND ANALYSIS (EUR 13M): The expected results are: (a) methodologies for anticipatory threat assessment, medical countermeasure requirements and consequence management; (b) a proposal for the long-term operation of the real-time prototype IT platform, for modelling tools if relevant, and for methodologies and protocols for intelligence gathering and analysis; (c) a global perspective assessment of surveillance and intelligence data, identification of required surveillance and intelligence data for serious cross-border threats to health and determining need to establish or reinforce systems;



#### HERA 'preparatory actions' in EU4Health 2021 WP

- **FLEXIBLE MANUFACTURING (EUR 40M):** The expected results of these actions are: (a) key details of technical specifications, volumes and types of product in order to enable manufacturing capacities for medical countermeasures (3M); (b) improve access to COVID-19 therapeutics at Union level (37M);
- Mapping (EUR 5M): The expected results is the identification (mapping) of the current developments and the future production of COVID-19 therapeutics and the availability of invitro diagnostics, as well as an analysis of the supply chains and any possible bottlenecks. Includes the development of an interactive mapping platform.
