## Outline of the Call document – Art 12(6)

**Article 12(6) concerning security restrictions** is applicable for topics DIGITAL-2024-CLOUD-DATA-06-**MANUFSPACE** and DIGITAL-2024-CLOUD-DATA-06-**HEALTHCARE-AI** 

Applicants (beneficiaries and affiliated entities) must be **legal entities established in <u>eliqible countries</u>** i.e.:

- EU Members States + Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein (listed EEA countries), or
- **DEP associated counties**, but only if they are formally associated to DEP and have received a positive assessment by the EC.

Furthermore, entities **established in associated countries and controlled from non-EU countries** may participate, if they submit a guarantee demonstrating that they have taken measures to ensure that their participation does not contravene security or EU strategic autonomy interests.

The ownership and control status of applicants will be determined based on the **Ownership Control Declaration** that must be submitted as part of the proposal (supporting documents will be requested later).



## Outline of the Call document – Art 12(6)

**Article 12(6) concerning security restrictions** is applicable for topics DIGITAL-2024-CLOUD-DATA-06-**MANUFSPACE** and DIGITAL-2024-CLOUD-DATA-06-**HEALTHCARE-AI** 

The security restrictions have an impact on a number of specific Grant Agreement provisions:

- project activities must take place in eligible countries
- subcontracted work must be performed in the eligible countries
- only costs for activities carried out in eligible countries are eligible
- exploitation must take place in eligible countries
- special rules for implementation, exploitation of results, transfers and exclusive licensing of results





For a proposal to be considered for funding, it MUST:

Pass the individual award criterion threshold for each criteria: **3 points** 

**AND** 

Obtain an overall score of or above **10 points** 

- All proposals that are scored below these thresholds will be rejected.
- Only proposals *above* these thresholds and within the limits of the *available call budget*, can be funded.

#### Admissibility requirements:

- Application form is readable before uploading Part B, check that it has been correctly converted to PDF and that there are no missing parts or missing tables.
- Always use the **standard template Part B**, downloaded from the submission system (not an old copy or own format).

#### Eligibility requirement:

- **Consortium composition compliance is a must** Read carefully *Section 6* of the call document and section *Targeted Stakeholders*.
- Ownership Control Declaration mandatory for topics DIGITAL-2024-CLOUD-DATA-06-MANUFSPACE and DIGITAL-2024-CLOUD-DATA-06-HEALTHCARE-AI





#### Ethics and Security issues table:

- Applicable for all topics.
- Mark with great attention the **relevant Ethics & Security issues**.
- Include the corresponding proposal Part B page in the respective table.
- Describe how your proposal complies with ethical principles and relevant legislation for any issues marked in the ethics form.

#### Award Criteria:

• Take into account the **award criteria** as detailed in the Call document and follow that logic in your application to provide all necessary information.





#### Page Limit:

- **70 pages** for topics DIGITAL-2024-CLOUD-DATA-06-**SKILLS** and DIGITAL-2024-CLOUD-DATA-06-**MANUFSPACE**
- 50 pages for topic DIGITAL-2024-CLOUD-DATA-06-HEALTHCARE-AI
- Any additional pages will be hidden
