Data Protection Notice for financial contribution scheme for HADEA staff members commuting by bicycle to and from work

Your personal data is processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 2018/1725¹ on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data.

Who is the data controller?

The **data controller** of the processing operation is the Head of Unit Staff, Communication and Support.

Which is the legal basis for processing your personal data?

The **legal basis** for the processing activities is Article 5(1)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 because the processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject and in particular the Decision of the HADEA Director of 25.05.2021² setting out a financial contribution scheme to HADEA staff members commuting by bicycle to and from work.

What is the purpose(s) of this processing activity?

The **purpose** of this processing is to be able to refund staff members who are eligible for the scheme.

Which personal data is collected?

The **following of your personal data are collected**: name, surname, perID, personal number, personal address, unpaid leaves periods, parental leaves/family leaves periods (used for the calculation of the reimbursement), bank account numbers are **mandatory** for the purpose(s) outline above. The personal address will be retrieved automatically from SYSPER and transferred to the HERO tool (application module³) to enable distance and related reimbursement calculations.

Who has access to the personal data of data subjects and to whom can they be disclosed?

The **recipients** of your personal data will be the competent persons in the HADEA HR People Sector and the Finance unit and bodies charged with monitoring or inspection

tasks in application of EU law (e.g. internal audits, Court of Auditors, European Anti-fraud Office (OLAF), EPPO).

Your personal data **will not be transferred** to third countries or international organisations.

The processing of your data will **not include automated decision-making** (such as profiling).

How long do we keep your personal data?

Your personal data will be kept for a maximum period of **60** months from the date of eligibility to the scheme – data from non-eligible staff data will be deleted. Data will be deleted at the end of this period.

What are your rights regarding your personal data?

You have the right to access your personal data and to request your personal data to be rectified, if the data is inaccurate or incomplete; where applicable, you have the right to request restriction or to object to processing, to request a copy or erasure of your personal data held by the data controller. If processing is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on your consent before its withdrawal.

Your request to exercise one of the above rights will be dealt with without undue delay and within **one month**.
