

# Digital Europe Programme Call for proposals

Call to Support the implementation of the European Digital Identity Framework

14 March 2022

#### Context

- Existing eIDAS regulation had **substantial shortcomings** including barriers to cross-border authentication in the private sector and when using mobile devices
  - Only 16 Member states implemented the recognition of eIDs in a cross-border context covering 14% of public service providers
- To address these shortcomings, the Commission proposed a revision of the current elDAS regulation to propose a European Digital Identity Framework
  - Obligation on member states to provide a European Digital Identity (EUDI) Wallets to all users who want to use them, with users in control of the data provided by the wallet to public/private services
- Europe's Digital Decade sets an ambitious target of four out of five EU citizens using
   Digital Identities by 2030 which preserve their right to privacy and data protection, whilst empowering them to exercise their freedoms in the digital realm



#### Context

- Ongoing work on the proposal for a EUDI framework is currently taking place along two strands;
- Legislative The revision of the eIDAS regulation is currently going through the legislative process with the European Parliament and the European Council with interinstitutional negotiations ongoing
- Technical Building on the proposal for a EUDI Framework, the Commission and member states adopted a Recommendation for common Union toolbox which sets out a coordinated approach towards a EUDI Framework



# **Objectives**

- Support the piloting of the European
   Digital Identity Wallets by Member States
   and relevant stakeholders in compliance with
   the common Union Toolbox and reference
   implementation of EUDI Wallet
- Promote the development and deployment of use-cases for the EUDI Wallet in different areas involving both public and private sector stakeholders
- Test the interoperability and scalability of use-cases within national and cross-border implementation contexts

- Trial user journeys and collect feedback for subsequent updates of the toolbox and the reference application of the EUDI Wallet
- Promote the opportunities of the EUDI Wallet among public and private sector stakeholders and users
- Help to build the necessary expertise and infrastructure to facilitate provision of the EUDI Wallet



# Scope

- Large-scale use-case pilots in areas of Mobile Driving Licence, eHealth,
   Education/Professional Qualifications, Payments; other areas (such as social security and digital travel credentials) will be also considered
- To be developed in compliance with Architecture and Reference Framework (ARF) set out in the common Union Toolbox and evolving reference application of EUDI Wallet
  - Toolbox will include commons standards, specifications and good practices as well as the Architecture and Reference Framework (ARF) for a reference implementation of the EUDI wallet
- Proposal should be in alignment with the outline of the ARF published on the stakeholder platform for the EUDI and set out the process of integration with the development of the reference application of the EUDI Wallet




# Scope

- The ARF will be published as part of the Toolbox recommendation in October 2022.
- Where appropriate, proposals should build on pre-existing work and make use of existing infrastructures. Applicants should also ensure alignment with other ongoing cross-border initiatives
- Projects run in pre-production environment that ensures oversight roles are filled by legally entitled entities and involving sufficient number of Wallet Users in testing
- Target proposals submitted by Governmental bodies responsible for issuing European Digital Identity Wallets



#### Roadmap



#### **Outcomes and Deliverables**

- Large scale pilots demonstrating the functionality of the Wallet in national and cross-border contexts
- Successful onboarding of EUDI Wallet users, credential/attribute providers and relying parties
- Contribute throughout the project duration to the development of the EUDI reference application including the successful integration of new releases of APIs for:
  - the issuance of Electronic Attestations of Attributes (EAAs), Qualified Attestations of Attributes (QEAAs) and credentials
  - the request and presentation of EAAs, QEAAs and credentials, and the validation of services (including connectivity and compliance tests)



#### Outcomes and Deliverables

- Completion of a sufficiently high number of cross-border transactions (i.e. with Issuers and Holders of EAAs, QEAAs and credentials, Wallet Issuers and Relying Parties coming from at least 3 different eligible countries) to demonstrate the Wallet's functionalities
- A **roadmap for** the implementation of, and recommendations for, the further development of the ecosystem and a **sustainability strategy**
- The integration of the interfaces of relying parties and EAA, QEAA and credential issuers to the Walletin their pre-production systems
- The trialling of user journeys involving relevant core functionalities of the Wallet
- Comprehensive testing of the cross-border functionality of Wallets in a pre-production environment demonstrating readiness to progress into production

### **KPIs**

- Number of Wallet issuing countries
- Number of holders of European Digital Identity Wallets
- Number of relying parties having integrated interfaces to the Wallet in their pre-production systems
- Number of Issuers of EAAs, QEAAs and Credentials having integrated interfaces to the Wallet in their preproduction systems

- Number of Wallet transactions completed in a pre-production environment
- Where relevant, number of qualified signatures issued by Wallet users



# Targeted Stakeholders

- Governmental bodies responsible for issuing EUDI Wallets
- Organisation needed to achieve the goals of a proposal in a particular domain:
  - National agencies responsible for the implementation of infrastructures and cross-border initiatives relevant to a use-case
  - Public and private relying parties, including but not limited to those required for piloting a usecase
  - Attribute/Attestations Providers
- Wallet users EU citizens and residents testing the functionality of the EUDI wallet
