### 1. Policy Background

#### **European Strategy for data**

- Focuses on **putting people first** in developing technology, and defending and promoting European values and rights in the digital world
- ➤ Aim is to create a genuine single market for data that ensures Europe's global competitiveness and data sovereignty
- Commission invests in **common European data spaces** in strategic economic sectors and domains of public interest
- ➤ Data spaces should foster an **ecosystem** where **new products and services** are created based on **more accessible data**
- > Staff Working Document that reviews the state of play of the common European data spaces



#### **Common European Data Space for Skills**

- → "to **reduce the skills mismatches** between the education and training system on the one hand and the labour market needs on the other<sup>1</sup>." [European Strategy for data]
- ➤ Preparatory Action finished in 2023: **DS4Skills**
- ➤ Main Outcomes:
  - ➤ <u>Data Space for Skills Blueprint</u>: comprehensive framework that addresses aspects ranging from business models and governance to technical architecture, user experience, and growth and roll out strategy.
  - ➤ <u>Interactive inventory of skills data initiatives</u>: collects and categorises initiatives operating or building skills & education data ecosystems



2. What are we looking for?

The development and deployment of a secure and trusted common European data space for skills

- integrate, test and deploy the technical infrastructure
- implementation of three use cases
- > put in place a **governance mechanism**
- rovide continuous maintenance operations, monitor the usage & offer a helpdesk
- > foster engagement
- > long-term economic sustainability



### Particular attention should be paid to:

- > Implementation of a minimum of three use cases
  - o e.g. data-based innovative solutions involving job offers, qualifications, learning opportunities, lists of curricula and certifications, etc.
- >Connecting data and service providers to the infrastructure
  - Includes providing guidance support and training documentation to reduce entry barriers, possibly onboarding events or networking opportunities



### 3. Any projects on which the proposal should build

- > outcomes of the <u>preparatory action</u> DS4Skills: must build upon the <u>Data Space for Skills Blueprint</u> and take into consideration the <u>Interactive inventory of skills data initiatives</u>
- > expected to integrate building blocks and infrastructure funded under the Call DIGITAL-2022-CLOUD-AI-03-PILOTS-CLOUD-SERVICES
- ➤ Work in close partnership with <u>DSSC</u> to <u>ensure alignment with the rest of ecosystem</u>, use (insofar as possible and when available) the smart middleware platform <u>SIMPL</u>
- ➤ Seek **complementarity with existing initiatives** in the domain of skills and qualifications → establish links to actions of these initiatives
- Take into account similar public or private data spaces developed at national or regional level across the EU.



- 4. Who are the types of main stakeholders that are addressed?
- higher education institutions, vocational education and training institutions, other education and training providers
- businesses, Human Resources (HR) organisations
- roviders providers
- >trade and industry associations, alliances and social partners
- ➤IT developers, other private and public actors (particularly in job search and recruitment services as well as data sharing)
