Regulation (EU) 2021/522 of the European
 Parliament and of the Council of 24 March
 2021 establishing a Programme for the Union's action in the field of health ('EU4Health Programme') for the period 2021-2027, and repealing Regulation (EU) No 282/2014







EU4Health – 4 General objectives

EU4Health is a clear message that public health is a priority for Europe: it is the response to COVID-19 crisis and it is the instrument to pave the way towards a European Health Union

Improve & foster health in the Union to reduce the burden of communicable and non-communicable diseases, by:

- promoting access to healthcare

Protect people in the Union from serious cross-border threats to health and strengthening the responsiveness of health systems and coordination among the MS in order to cope with serious cross-border threats to health

Improve the availability, accessibility and affordability of medicinal products and medical devices, and crisis-relevant products in the Union, and supporting innovation regarding such products

Strengthen the national health systems by improving their resilience and resource efficiency through:

- supporting integrated and coordinated work between MS:
- promoting the implementation of best practices & promoting data sharing;
- reinforcing the healthcare workforce;
- tackling the implications of demographic challenges;
- advancing digital transformation



10 months after adoption of the Programme, more than EUR 1 billion has been made available for investment through the WP2021 and WP2022










EU4Health is implemented through <u>annual work programmes</u>


